Sub: Action Points on impl ementation of SSEPD Programmes.

Madam/Sir,

On 20.7.2016 the State Level Conference of DSSOs was held in which the progress regarding implementation of various schemes of SSEPD Department was reviewed. A number of initiatives need to be taken up by the District Administration such as completion of digitisation of pension database and seeding of Aadhar number, implementation of Nirman Shramik Pension Yojana in the pattern of MBPY, setting up of DDRC, Drug De-Addiction Centres and Old Age Home in every district and mainstreaming of Transgenders. A brief outline of all the steps required to be taken up by the District Administration is enclosed.

You are requested to ensure proper implementation of the programmes of SSEPD Department according to the action points enclosed.

Pension

Sl. No.	Action Points
1.	Digitization of NSAP and MBPY to be completed by July, 2016 end.
2.	Seeding of Aadhar number in pension database should be completed by July, 2016 end.
3.	Disbursement of pension under Nirman Shramik Pension Yojana should be completed immediately in accordance with MBPY guidelines.
4.	Social audit should be conducted in other parts of the district not yet covered.

Persons with Disabilities

Sl. No.	Action Points
1.	Information sought by GoI regarding the bank account details for releasing funds for implementation of UDID should be submitted under counter signature of the bank manager to the Joint Secretary Agnibesh Agasti, Deptt. of PwDs, GoI.
2.	At least 100 cases per Block and at least 500 cases per ULB of eligible students for pre-matric, post-matric, top class, overseas scholarship should be identified and sponsored.
3.	For awareness generation, publicity schemes names of 5 PwD students in every district for tour outside the state should be submitted to the SSEPD Department.
4.	Under awareness and publicity scheme proposals should be formulated and submitted for helpline, organisation of workshops and conferences, printing of leaflets, pamphlets etc for awareness generation.
5.	In every Block and ULB 100 cases of PwDs may be identified and sponsored for vocational training in ITI, Jatni, empanelled training institutions, under DDUGKY scheme, RSETI and ORLM etc.
6.	For rehabilitation of PwDs the requirement of CMRF fund may be indicated if there is shortage of CMRF fund.
7.	PwDs should be identified under Marriage incentive scheme.
8.	Under the insurance scheme namely Swabalamban all PwDs should be sponsored.
9.	In every district at least one Special School should be opened for PwDs.
10.	In every district one DDRC should be established for which proposal along with required documents should be submitted under SIPDA.
11.	Application from eligible visually impaired students for laptops should be collected and submitted.
12.	Under SIPDA proposals should be submitted for grant of funds from Govt. of India. Proposals can cover various activities like making building and websites accessible to PwDs, setting up of early diagnostic and intervention centres, skill development programmes, establishment of recreation centres for PwDs, DDRC, training and capacity building, etc.
13.	Constitution of local level committee under National Trust, holding of its meetings and submission of proposals under the 10 Schemes of National Trust particularly under Sahayogi and Badhte Kadam Schemes.
14.	Partnership with ORLM for creation of PwD SHGs, skill development and placement.
15.	Making DSSO member of District Level Coordination Committee of ORLM and building partnership between BSSO and BPM at Block level.

Senior Citizens

Sl. No.	Action Points
1.	Proposal for operation of at least one Old Age Home in each district by NGO or through District Red Cross Society should be submitted.
2.	The meeting of District Level Senior Citizen Committee should be regularly held.
3.	Nomination should be submitted under Govt. of India scheme of Baristha Nagarika Samman.
4.	All police officers should be sensitized and the Districts should adopt the senior citizens security arrangement model as implemented by Bhubaneswar Commissionerate Police.

Transgenders

Sl. No.	Action Points
1.	Organisation of camps, workshops, awareness programmes in the district for sensitizing officials and transgenders about the challenges faced by the transgenders and the steps taken by Government to benefit them.
2.	Including transgenders for enrolment under Aadhar scheme, giving them voter identity cards, ration cards as priority households, SHG formation, skill development and placement under ORLM. All transgenders are covered under auto-inclusion category of ORLM.
3.	Provision of vocational training to transgenders under DDUGKY etc.
4.	Providing necessary health care support.

Drug De-Addiction

Sl. No.	Action Points
1.	Every district operate a drug de-addiction centre either run by NGO or by District Red Cross Society.
2.	Proposals to be submitted under the National Fund for Control of Drug Abuse scheme of Govt. of India for awareness generation on drug abuse, capacity building of officials and vocational training of the drug dependant victims.
3.	Identification of persons with mental illness arising due to drug addiction.
4.	Implementation of the recommendations of the Commissioner appointed by the Hon'ble High Court on control of drug abuse in Odisha.
